Extended Minerals Declaration

Manufacturer Declaration of Conformity

Extended minerals are defined as cobalt and mica minerals (micas) or their derivatives. Cobalt is an essential element in electronics and is primarily used in lithium-ion batteries. Mica is a mineral used in paints, automobile parts, shingles, electronics, and cosmetic items. Cobalt and mica are often mined in conflict-affected areas, contributing to unethical sourcing issues.

Based on the definition above Traco Electronic AG (TRACO) declares that:

TRACO does not directly purchase any of the Extended Minerals from non-conformant smelters.

TRACO POWER products have been manufactured without the intentional use of Extended Minerals from non-conformant smelters.

TRACO has implemented processes and procedures to help ensure that our suppliers comply with our expectations. We have communicated our requirements to our supplier base to determine the sources of any Extended Mineral contained in our products. We have subsequently obtained declarations from our supplier base confirming their commitment and upstream diligence.
